Step 1: Identify Barriers to Learning

Question: What is preventing some students from accessing or demonstrating learning?

Actions:

- Review student work, assessment data, and observations.
 - Identify academic, behavioral, language, or engagement barriers.
 - Focus on students who may not be experiencing success.
